Appointment of Chaplaincy of the Association to the Reverend Father Bill Pearson.

The Board of Directors is honoured to announce that Fr. Bill Pearson has kindly accepted to act as our Association's Chaplain. Fr. Bill and his wife Lorna have been avid attendees at the Association's events for many years. In fact, Fr. Bill's involvement has included the saying of the Prayers and Benedictions at our Association's Commemorations, and the performance of Grace at Dinner Functions. As well, he was the Key-Note Speaker at our Association's 2019 Thanksgiving Dinner, and has a reputation for telling a good Nautical joke or two.

On 30th September 2019, the Redland City Bulletin reported that Fr Bill was honoured by the highest figure in the Brisbane Anglican Church, for 45 years of service to the Mission to Seafarers, including his work helping to honour fallen sailors. He was presented with a certificate by Brisbane Archbishop Phillip Aspinall at the 2019 Annual Seafarers' Memorial Service, which also marked his retirement from the Seafarers' Day Committee. It came as he prepared to celebrate 60 years in the church, having been ordained as a Deacon in Townsville on December 6, 1959.

After serving with the Royal Australian Navy and in various Queensland parishes for nearly three decades, he was recalled to Mission to Seafarers as a senior chaplain and head of the Mission to Seafarers, Brisbane. Fr. Bill said he had always had a connection to the sea, having been born in the great British Seafaring City of Liverpool. The Association congratulates Fr. Bill for all of his outstanding lifetime achievements and further wishes him a very happy and healthy 85th Birthday.


